Who is eligible?

- A First Time Homebuyer who has not owned a home (individually or jointly) within the past 3 years.
- All homebuyers must occupy the home as their primary residence once purchased.
- All homebuyers must participate in the Riviera Beach Homebuyers Club.
- For most programs, participants must also provide sweat equity and volunteer hours.
- Household income must not exceed the established income limits. (Some programs allow up to 120% AMI.)
